Medical Missions

CALM conducted a medical mission at the Aglalana Church of Christ on January 13, as reported in last month's newsletter. Two weeks later, two people who attended the mission, committed their lives to Christ and were baptized at Aglalana.



A medical mission was held at the Banate Church of Christ on March 24. Twenty volunteers served 128 residents with medical care, medicine, and spiritual counseling. Meals were served to approximately 40 children. IDES assisted in the mission by providing funding for medicine and food.
