Help Needed

The Taft North Church of Christ's (Juanito's home church) meeting place needs some major repairs. The roof is rotting and needs to be replaced. The building was designed to be a two-story structure with the first floor to be used for classrooms and the second floor for the sanctuary. The church could not afford to put on the second floor twenty years ago so only the first floor was constructed. They had hoped the temporary roof would last until the second floor could be completed. Unfortunately, the wood is rotting, and the metal sheeting is rusting. The recent typhoon resulted in flooding; obviously repairs are necessary.

The congregation would like to complete the original two-story design, but at a minimum, must replace the roof covering the first floor. A preliminary estimate for just repairing the roof would be about \$5,500 for materials; completing the second floor would be about \$24,000 for materials. The congregation has a little money saved but not even enough for the minimum repairs. Any gift to meet this need would be greatly appreciated.
