IBS started the first semester for the current school year on June 16 with six students. Three students from last year were not able to continue due to financial hardship. In addition to their studies, the students are serving in local churches on the weekends as part of their training.

They had hoped to be able to start a new Freshmen class at the same time but due limited financial resources that is not possible at this time. The dedicated teachers and students are making real progress in developing the next generation of leaders for the CALM Philippines churches but struggle financially. Immediate needs include two computers for the students to use, an electronic keyboard for musical training, food and lodging for the students, and especially textbooks for instruction. The students are supported by their families and home churches but they are poor and have limited funds.

**Juanito's Travels**

He preached at the Concepcion Church of Christ on June 8 to help them celebrate the congregation's seventh anniversary. Four young ladies accepted the Lord and were baptized the next day.

He preached at the Baldoza Church of Christ on June 15. Three people responded to the message and became Christians. He had a Bible study the next day at Agtambo with a young woman and she was baptized.

Juanito helped the Tigayon Church of Christ in Kalibo celebrate their sixteenth anniversary June 22 by speaking for their service.

He then preached at the Belison Church of Christ in Antique on June 29. One person was baptized following the service. The Belison church meets in a house, which the congregation has outgrown, and led by a lay leader who receives no compensation. They have a small piece of property nearby where they would like to build a church building that could accommodate about 120 people. The estimated cost would be around \$10,000.
