Weather

The Philippines has experienced a lot of severe weather this fall which has had an impact on the ministry of CALM Philippines. A medical mission was scheduled at Guimaras on November 8 but had to be postponed due to a typhoon. It was rescheduled for November 29 but that one had to be postponed due to the third typhoon in November. It was possible to hold a medical mission at Aglalana on November 22 but heavy rains earlier in the week may have resulted in lower attendance. The medical mission at Aglalana was originally scheduled for October but had to be rescheduled because of a tropical storm and flooding. Many of the churches experienced flooding and storm damage at their meeting place in the members' homes during the month.

Medical Mission

Seventy-one residents of Aglalana were served at the medical mission at Aglalana Church of Christ on November 22. Approximately 15 children received a meal and a Bible story. Two who were in attendance committed their life to the Lord and were baptized the next day. The gospel is always shared with all participants in the medical missions.
